1: 50.1.3 Cooking equipment used in fixed, mobile, or temporary concessions, such as trucks, buses, trailers, pavilions, tents, or any form of roofed enclosure, shall comply with NFPA 96. [96:1.1.3]

### **Violations**

Failure to have <b>proper mounting/spacing</b> of propane tanks
Failure to have portable generator spaced properly
Failure to properly store flammable liquids
Missing/inoperable/inaccessible, or not serviced fire extinguishers

### **NFPA Code References**

#### LP(Propane)/CNG(Natural Gas)

- 1: 50.8.7.7.6.1 Cylinders in storage shall be located to minimize exposure to excessive temperature rises, physical damage, or tampering.
- 1: 50.8.7.1.1 Cylinders shall be secured in an upright position to prevent tipping over.
- <u>101: 11.11.6.1.3</u> Containers for liquefied petroleum gases shall be installed not less than 60 in. (1525 mm) from any tent and shall be in accordance with the provisions of  $\underline{\mathsf{NFPA}}$  58.

#### Generator

1: 50.8.5.4.3 Internal combustion engine power sources shall be positioned so that the exhaust complies with the following: 1)Located at least 12ft from openings, air intakes, and means of egress. 2)In a position away from any building. 3) In a position pointed away from any mobile or temporary cooking operation.

#### Fire Extinguishers

- 1: 50.4.11.2 Class K fire extinguishers shall be provided for cooking appliance hazards that involve combustible cooking media (vegetable oils and animal oils and fats). [96:10.9.2]
- 1: 50.4.11.1 Portable fire extinguishers shall be selected and installed in kitchen cooking areas in accordance with Section 13.6 and shall be specifically listed for such use.
- 1: 50.5.7.5 A minimum of one 2A:10BC portable fire extinguisher shall be provided when a generator or other fuel fired appliance is used.
